“The Milestones of Law in the Area of Central Europe 2018”

Dear colleagues,

we are happy to hereby invite you all to the 12th annual international scholarly conference for Ph.D. students and young researchers entitled “*The Milestones of Law in the Area of Central Europe 2018*” organised by the Faculty of Law of Comenius University in Bratislava (FL CU).

The conference will be held under the auspices of the Dean of FL CU in the premises of the special purpose facility of the National Council of SR in **Častá – Papiernička** from **12 April to 14 April 2018** (starting at 12.00 p.m. on Thursday and finishing at 13:00 p.m. on Saturday).

The conference is intended for all Ph.D. students and law researchers who have not obtained the scientific and pedagogical title of associate professor yet.

Please fill in the requested information in the **Registration** section including the **title of the paper** (also in English) which you will present at the conference (**presenting** a paper at the conference is one of the requirements which have to be met in order to have your paper published in reviewed conference proceedings; these requirements shall apply without any exceptions).

The registration **starts on 24 February 2018** and **ends on 25 March 2018**. The number of participants is limited for capacity reasons. If you manage to register before the capacity has been full and you meet the requirement of registration for a particular topic, a call for paying the **conference fee in the amount of 85 €** will be sent to the email address you have provided. Please, pay the given amount via a bank transfer within 10 days, otherwise you will be removed from the list of participants and we will give the opportunity to participate in a conference to another interested participant. Other participants who will not be able to participate in the conference for capacity reasons will be notified thereof by email.

Important notice!

- **Participants shall register for a particular topic.**
- **Abstracts shall be provided by participants already at the registration.**
- **The topic of your paper will be confirmed by a head of section and you will be notified thereof by email; subsequently an e-invoice will be sent to you.**
- **The paper in its final form needs to be submitted until 14 April 2018 via electronic registration system**

Please note that the conference fee does not cover all conference costs and further costs shall be paid from the contributions provided by conference partners. **Each participant will be provided** (without incurring any further costs) with accommodation for 2 nights and board for three days (starting with lunch on the first day and ending with lunch on the third day). **However, conference participants shall arrange the transportation to and from the conference on their own.**

Conference e-proceedings will be prepared from the papers sent by their authors. **In order to have your paper published in the proceedings, the following requirements have to be met:**

- **presenting the paper at the conference,**
- **preparing the paper according to the set template,**
- **sending the paper within the set deadline,**
- **recommendation of the publication of the paper by the assigned reviewer.**

Further instructions and detailed conference program will be sent electronically no later than 10 days before the conference is held.
